Threat # 7 : Handling and storage of non-agricultural source material

Policy Summary for those applying, handling, and storing category 1 NASMs

All current and future land applications of category 1 non-agricultural source materials that pose a potential significant threat to drinking water, will need to occur outside of the immediate area surrounding municipal wells (WHPA-A) and intakes (IPZ-1). In addition, all handling and storage facilities will need to be moved/ constructed outside of WHPA-A/IPZ-1. *(Policy #'s NASM (App)-2 & NASM (H&S)-2)*

A risk management plan needs to be negotiated between the risk management official and those applying, handling or storing category 1 non-agricultural source materials to land in significant threat areas outside of WHPA-A/IPZ-1. The risk management plan will reflect appropriate nutrient management practices. *(Policy #'s NASM (App)-1 & NASM (H&S)-1)*

Policy Summary for those applying, handling, and storing category 2 & 3 NASMs

Where the application of category 2 and 3 non-agricultural source materials would pose a significant threat to drinking water, existing Environmental Compliance Approvals (C of As / ECAs) will be amended to direct the application of these materials away from WHPA-A,B, and IPZ-1. *(Policy # NASM (App)-3)*

All existing Environmental Compliance Approvals (C of As / ECAs) will be amended to direct the handling and storage of category 2 and 3 non-agricultural source materials away from areas immediately surrounding municipal wells (WHPA-A) and intakes(IPZ-1). *(Policy # NASM (H&S)-3)*

Future Environmental Compliance Approvals (ECAs/C of As) will not be issued for the application, handling and storage of category 2 and 3 non-agricultural source materials within the significant threat area. *(Policy #'s NASM (App)-4 & NASM (H&S)-4)*
