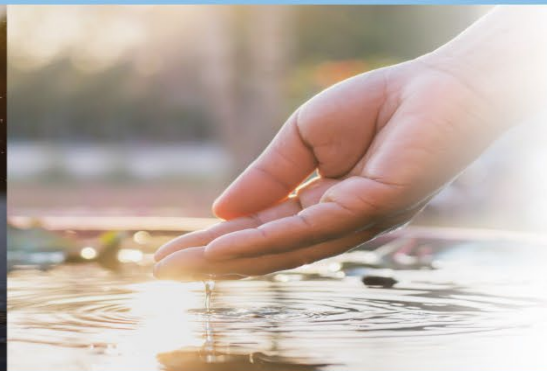

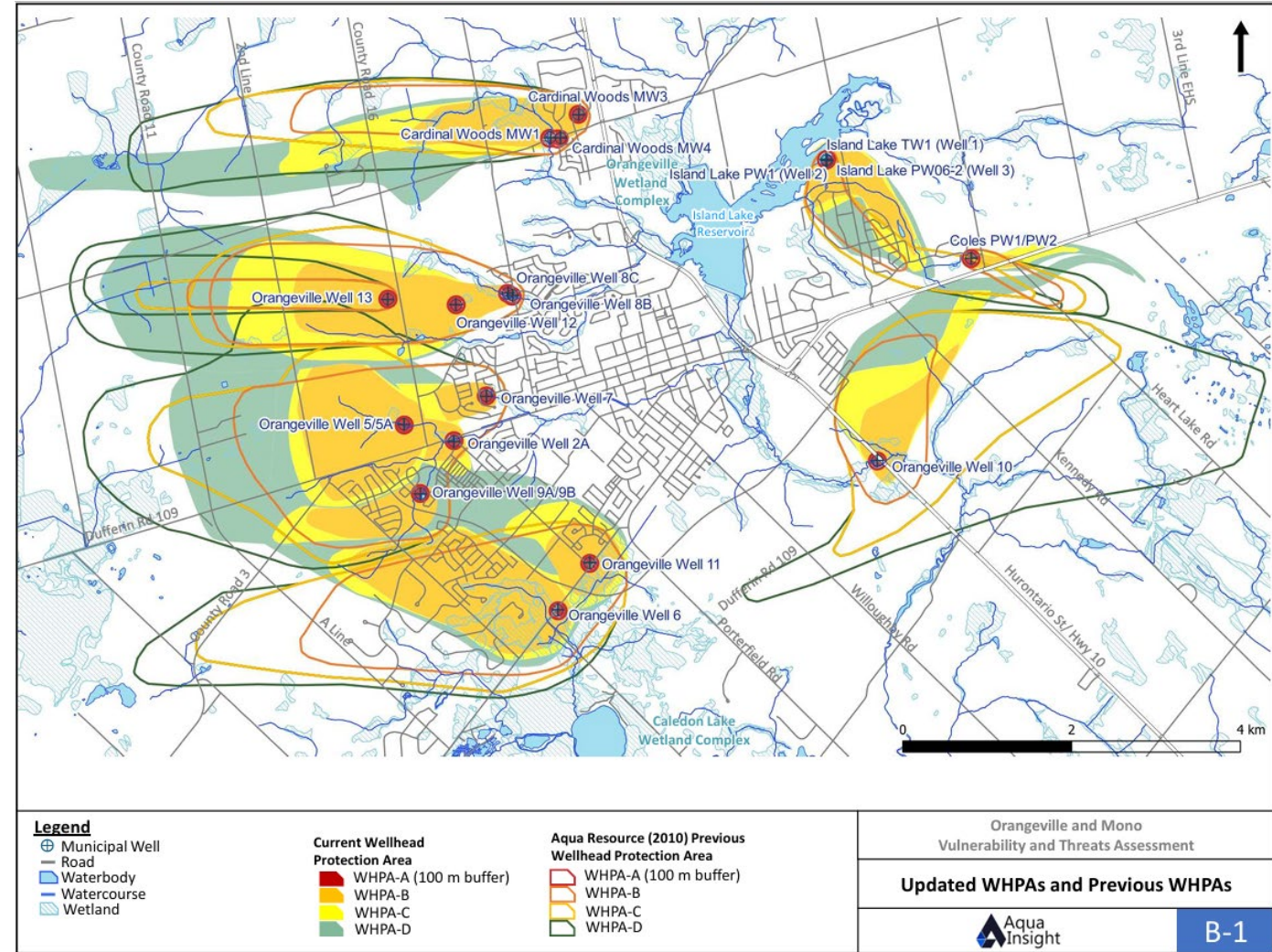

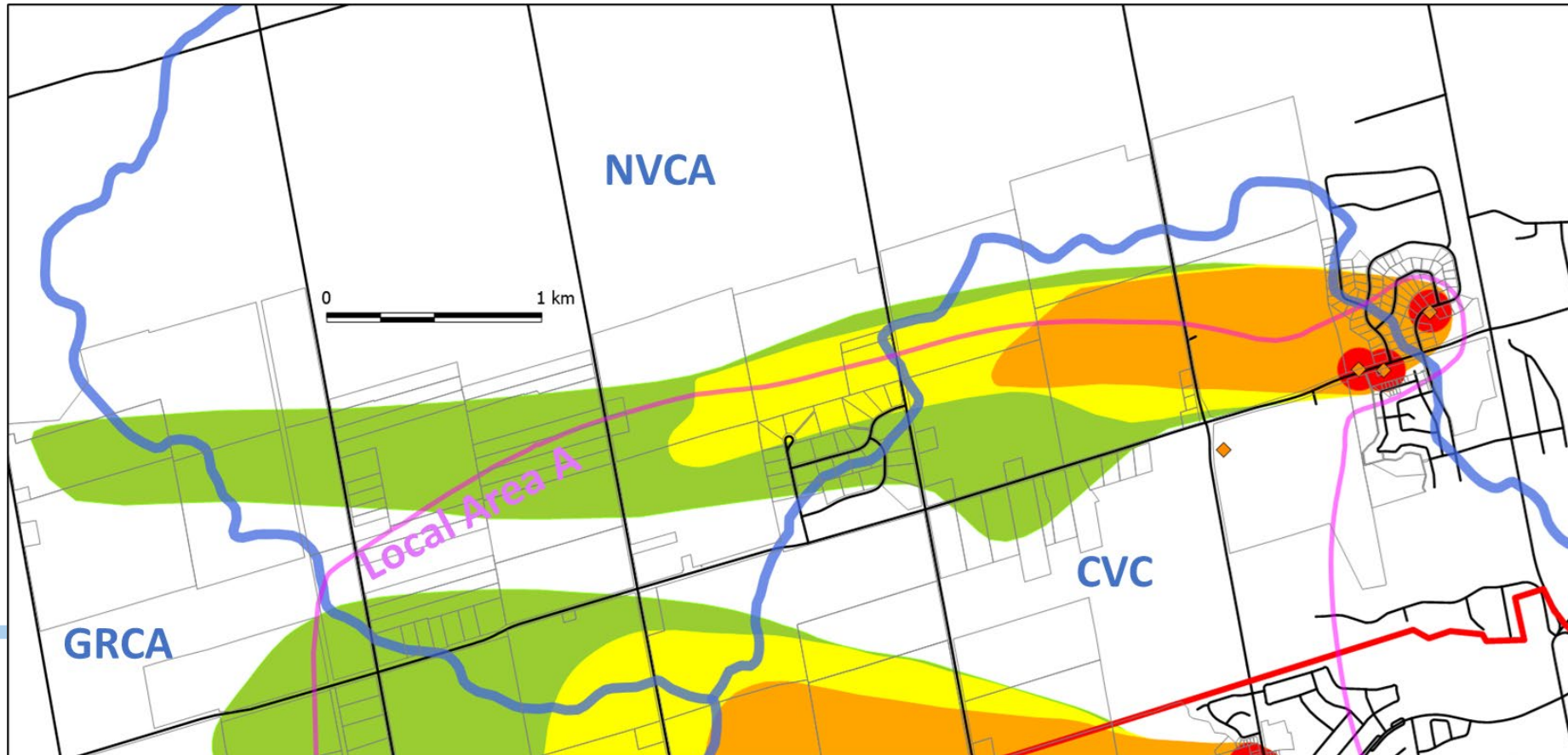
Introduction & Context

- Orangeville Well 13 triggered an update to Tier 3 water budget & WHPAs delineation.
- Joint amendment process by three SPAs
CTC, LESPR & NVSPA
- The wellhead protection areas for all wells in the study area were revised
- Very small changes and impacts for the NVSPA area

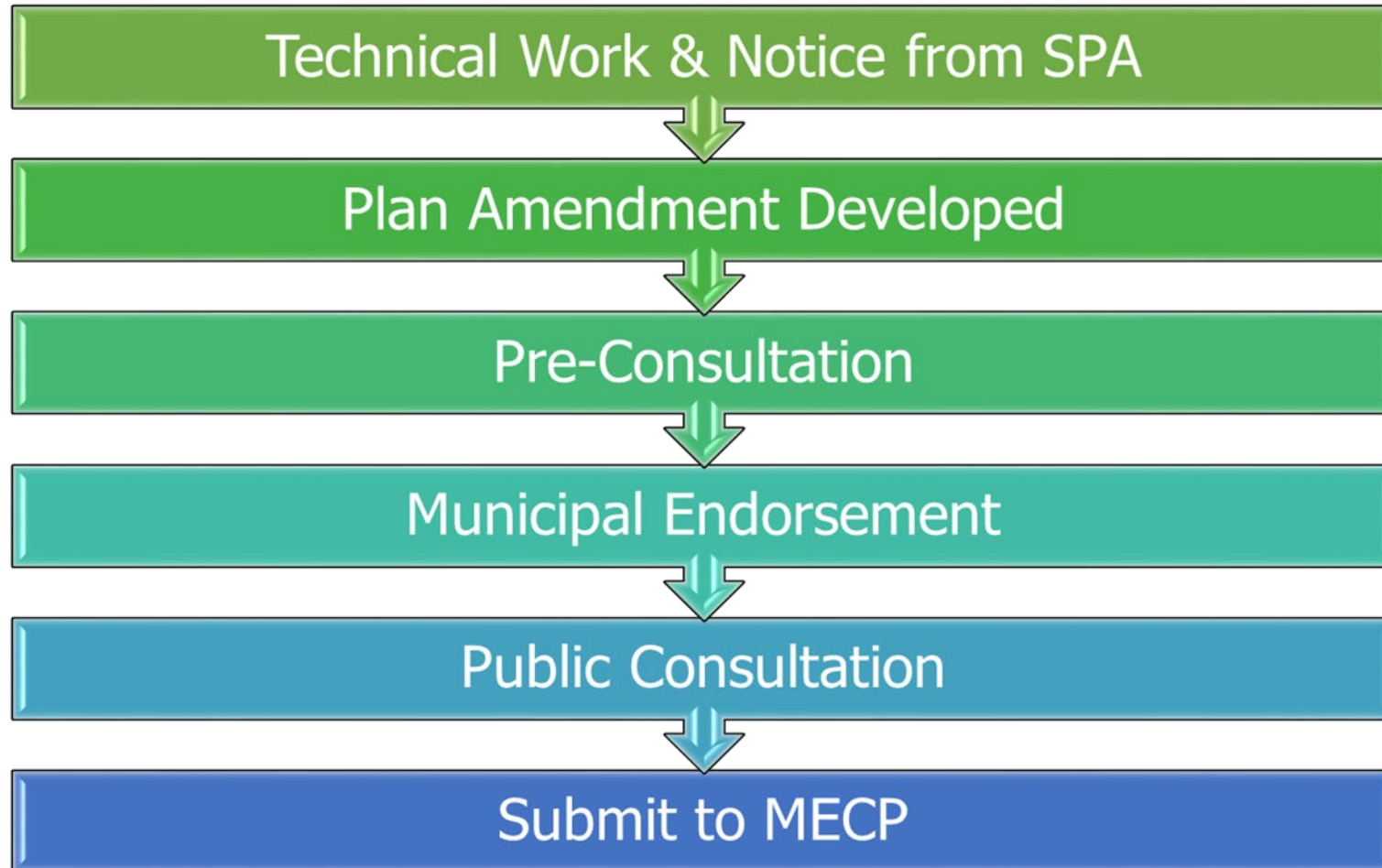


Local Source Protection Plan Policy Implications

- No anticipated policies changes are required.
- No new significant drinking water threats were identified within Nottawasaga Valley Source Protection Authority



Next Steps in Section 34 Process



Progress in the Section 34 process

1. Early Engagement with the Ministry of the Environment, Conservation and Parks: June 2025-February 2026.
2. Section 48(1.1) b Notice of Amendments to Source Protection Plan – issued jointly by the three source protection authorities: April 2026
3. Source Protection Committee meeting: June 2026.
4. Pre-consultation with implementing bodies (Mono, Orangeville, County of Dufferin, Ministry, etc.): June 2026.
5. Municipal endorsement: August 2026.
6. Public consultation: July – August 2026
7. Wrap up and submission to the Ministry for approval: To be determined

Note: Steps 4 through 7 are being led primarily by CTC as the lead source protection authority

Recommendation

That presentation a) and Staff Report SPC2.1 regarding Source Protection Plan and Assessment Report Update – Technical Report in support of the Orangeville-Mono Tier 3 Update and addition of Well 13, Section 34 Amendment be received for information; and

Further That the South Georgian Bay – Lake Simcoe Source Protection Committee agree that the proposed amendments to the Town of Mono chapter of the Assessment Report is advisable.
